# SAFE Rehoming continues its journey...

SAFE powered into its second year of operation and has continued to help pets in need all throughout Sydney. While the incoming animal numbers dropped dramatically this year, our adoption number is slightly increased. The drop in incoming pets is no doubt in line with the drop in foster carer capacity, even cat foster carers are hard to come by and we have to be careful not to overwhelm the carers we do have. The increase in adoption is most likely brought on by SAFE further establishing itself in the area as well as multiple adoption events undertaken throughout the year.

All in all its been a successful year for SAFE with many pets finding their new forever homes and many more being rescued from unfortunate circumstances.

# President and Treasurer's Report

This year has been one of consolidation which has seen SAFE continue to go from strength to strength. The committee has continued to work tirelessly to move. As well as searching for a premises, we have been trying to engage SAFE with the community more to position the SAFE 'brand' in front of as many people as possible. We have done this by attending many events over the 12 months including 3 successful adoption events and the 2018 Sydney Dog Lovers Show. The adoptions events resulted in 17 adoptions and by attending the Dog Lovers Show the SAFE name reach almost 30,000 visitors over the two days of the event.

While several of our pets have had unfortunate medical issues to deal, our the support base has always stepped up to help. However, while it's important to acknowledge this support, we always try to focus on the positive and the happy stories of each year. For instance, Sammy the cat was adopted in March 2019 after being in care for almost 18 months. This was not only a proud moment for SAFE but also for both of his foster carers and it proved that there truly is a home for every pet.

The finances this year have been interesting. We have had similar expenses but the veterinary fees are not vastly different from the previous year and this is largely because although less animals in care, on average we have had to spend more on each animal. Pets such as Ethan and Emmett of course bring the average up, but these cases are precisely why SAFE exists.

With all of this in mind I'm pleased to say we scraped through the year with a profit but our income was significantly lower whilst our expenditure only decreased marginally. This highlights the need for us to expand and engage with our support network moving forward.

With the new year much of the way through I hope we can increase the number of animals we help. With the support of members and the community as a whole I look forward to a future of working together.
